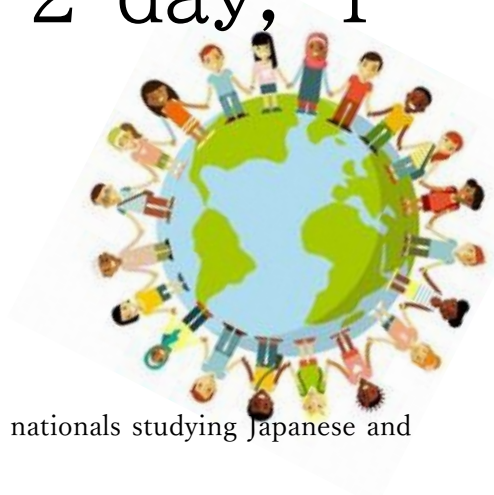




Interact with people from various countries at a 2-day, 1-night camp
